- One outstanding cheque needs to be cashed.
- Uncommitted funds are approx. \$13,000. However, uncommitted funds will decrease once the grade 8 leaving ceremony costs are accounted for later in the month. We have unused funds for special ed., student leadership, miscellaneous, arts and gym.
- The final net income will be about double (approx. \$10,000) of what we projected because of unspent funds.

- PRO grant status no report yet from Lesley Ireton. Ms. Coulson noted that Eva Olson, a holocaust survivor, is booked at the school for October. The "Humanity Bus" program would be ideal too, in which classes go in, one by one, for topical issues bullying, justice, equity.

- Chocolate Fundraising program Keri Coulson met recently with Nora Kennedy (parent volunteer) who has run past chocolate campaigns for the school council and is willing to organize the campaign next year. Lesley I and Nora K have also been in contact. All council members expressed willingness to help with the campaign. Rob will follow up with Nora. Will plan to sell the \$3 bars.
